



What is the 'Absolutorium' (certificate of completion)?

A certificate of completion is a confirmation of completion of all the courses included in the program of studies, with exception of the last cycle of degree seminars. The last cycle of degree seminars is completed once you submit your diploma thesis.

What is the deadline for the diploma examination?

Deadline for the diploma examination is the last day of the last semester of your studies. In case of students beginning their studies in October, it will be the 30th September of the last year of studies.

Is it possible to postpone the defence (diploma examin)?

Yes, in case of the student's long illness or other legitimate reasons, beyond control of the student or the thesis supervisor, the HTU may extend the duration of studies by no more than 3 months from the scheduled date of completion. Additionally, it is possible to postpone the diploma examination if there were reasons on the part of the thesis supervisor which could significantly delay the submission of the thesis.



Completion of studies

What happens if my date of completion of studies was postponed by 3 months, but still I did not manage to pass the diploma exam?

A student who has achieved the Absolutorium (except for passing the last cycle of the degree seminar due to the failure to submit a thesis) will be removed from the student list. In such a case, the student may apply to HTU for resumption of studies (up to two years after the removal). After resumption, the student can complete the last cycle of seminars and pass the diploma exam.
