Conditions, repeating stages (year, semester)

What is a condition?

Condition, or „conditional entry“. It is granted to a student who has not completed the course(s) required at a given stage (year/semester) of studies. In that case the student is conditionally transferred to the next year/semester of study – he has to repeat the failed course and pass it.

How many conditions can you have?

The conditions cannot exceed the maximum value of 20 ECTS points per year – i.e. $\frac{1}{3}$ of the value of ECTS points from a given stage of studies.

Let's consider it with examples:

Johnny did not pass the following course at 1st year: „Introduction to statistics“ for 12 ECTS points, „Introduction to philosophy“ for 5 ECTS points and „Techniques of scientific work“ for 3 ECTS points. This means that Johnny has not completed the classes for a total of 20 ECTS points, so in accordance with the Study Regulations, he may take the conditions of these three courses, because the sum of ECTS does not exceed 20 ECTS.

Andy has a similar situation to Johnny, but he also was off his game on the course „The Life and Work of Zenek Martyniuk“ for 2 ECTS points, so the sum of ECTS for failed subjects is 22 points (12 + 5 + 3 + 2), so Andy cannot take conditions from these classes, but must be directed to repeating the year.

How many times can you have a condition with a given course?

One course can only be repeated 1 time, i.e. only 1 time you can have the condition of the course. If the course is passed for the second time, then you may be assigned to repeat the stage.

What is year/semester repetition?

When a student cannot apply for a conditional enrollment due to too many failed classes, they are directed to repeat a year / semester, which means that they are not enrolled in the next stage and must repeat and complete all failed courses. Additionally, you can be directed to repeat a stage when you have failed a given course more than once or when you are at the last stage of your studies. **A given year of studies can also be repeated up to one time.**
