

Individual organisation of studies

What does individual organisation of studies (IOS) mean?

Individual organisation of studies comprises:

- individual study program implemented in cooperation with the academic tutor
- individual study plan
- individual process and time frame for obtaining course credits
- individual study process for disabled students or students suffering from a chronic illness

To whom can I apply for the IOS?

Requests for the IOS should be addressed to the HTU.

Who can apply for the individual organisation of studies?

The following categories of students can apply for the IOS:

- students pursuing studies in more than one field e.g. when a collision occurs between the dates of exams;
- students achieving outstanding learning outcomes;
- students participating in research works not included in the study plan;
- students with outstanding sport, cultural and artistic achievements;
- students referred to study at another domestic or foreign university or institution;
- students with disabilities or suffering from a chronic illness;
- students who are parents or pregnant students; in other
- justified cases e.g. fortuitous events;
