# Individual organisation of studies

## What does individual organisation of studies (IOS) mean?

Individual organisation of studies comprises:

- individual study program implemented in cooperation with the academic tutor
- individual study plan
- individual process and time frame for obtaining course credits
- individual study process for disabled students or students suffering from a chronic illness

## To whom can I apply for the IOS?

Requests for the IOS should be addressed to the HTU.

## Who can apply for the individual organisation of studies?

The following categories of students can apply for the IOS:

- students pursuing studies in more than one field – e.g. when a collision occurs between the dates of exams;
- students achieving outstanding learning outcomes;
- students participating in research works not included in the study plan;
- students with outstanding sport, cultural and artistic achievements;
- students referred to study at another domestic or foreign university or institution;
- students with disabilities or suffering from a chronic illness;
- students who are parents or pregnant students; in other justified cases – e.g. fortuitous events;
