

**The minimum for MISH and MISMaP students from the 2025/26 academic year onwards (*Cognitive Science* programme – second-cycle studies)**

Interfaculty students are subject to the same requirements as other Cognitive Science students regarding the minimum ECTS credits for each module and the completion of Diploma Seminars and Research Labs. For interfaculty students, the minimum total number of ECTS credits across all modules is set at 50. The following table presents the details.
